



WoodWorks Issues ‘Call for Nominations’ for the 2018 U.S. Wood Design Awards

WoodWorks, an educational initiative that provides free technical support and resources related to the design and construction of non-residential and multi-family wood buildings, is accepting nominations for its 2018 U.S. Wood Design Awards. The awards recognize excellence in wood design, engineering, and construction, as well as innovative projects that showcase attributes of wood such as strength, beauty, versatility, cost effectiveness, and sustainability. The deadline for nominations is **September 29, 2017**.

Projects may be submitted in the following categories:

- Multi-Family Wood Design
- Commercial Wood Design – Low-Rise
- Commercial Wood Design – Mid-Rise
- Wood in Schools
- Institutional Wood Design
- Green Building with Wood
- Beauty of Wood
- Wood in Government Buildings
- Durable & Adaptable Wood Structures

Award submissions must be received by midnight PT on September 29, 2017. There are no nomination fees and multiple submissions are encouraged. To be eligible, projects and nominated firms must be in the U.S. and projects must be fully constructed by September 29, 2017. Except for the Durability & Adaptability of Wood Structures category, Wood Design Awards apply to new construction only, which includes significant additions.
